



GAMBLING MINI-GRANTS UP TO FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS

The Pennsylvania Department of Health, Bureau of Drug & Alcohol Programs (BDAP) is pleased to announce that it will offer mini-grants of up to \$5,000 to develop programs related to public education, awareness and training to promote the treatment and prevention of compulsive and problem gambling.

The mini-grants are available to qualified individuals and agencies. The primary objectives are to establish and enhance collaborative relationships and increase awareness and knowledge in the area of problem and compulsive gambling, increase referral and engagement into treatment for problem gambling, and to implement activities directed toward changing individual and community norms regarding problem gambling behaviors.
