The Pennsylvania Peer Support Coalition (PPSC) is now accepting memberships. If you provide peer support to others, please join the Coalition and help build a stronger peer support movement in Pennsylvania!

The Coalition's purpose is to ensure that peer support services are consumer-driven, to provide resources and support for individuals who provide peer support, and to advocate for peer support in Pennsylvania. The Pennsylvania Mental Health Consumers' Association (PMHCA) serves as fiduciary for the Coalition, and a volunteer steering committee provides direction for the Coalition.

Any individual who provides peer support to help others recover from mental health or co-occurring disorders is welcome to join. Coalition membership is not limited to Certified Peer Specialists. All members must identify as consumers/survivors/peers/individuals in recovery from mental illness.

- Technical assistance on topics related to peer support
